Itinerary

Prague – Vienna – Bratislava – Budapest

Day 1 Depart

Our journey begins as we board our plane, and depart on our overnight flight to Munich, Germany! **IF**

Day 2 Prague

We land in Munich, Bavaria's fun loving capital and city where music, art, sport and good cheer have always been a significant part of its culture. A local guide will take us on a walking tour through this beautiful city, showing us such sights as the **Prague Castle, the Golden Lane, the Charles Bridge and the Astronomical Clock.** **B/D**

Day 3 Prague

This morning we enjoy a guided visit of the **Old Jewish Cemetery and Museum** today, including Pinkas Synagogue which houses children's artwork from Theresienstadt. After seeing the old Jewish Quarter, we have some free to explore the city on our own this afternoon. Prague's lovely Baroque architecture and winding cobblestone streets will lead us to many interesting sights. **B/D**

Day 4 Prague

Today will be a free day in Prague for participation in a service project in Prague. **B/D**

Day 5 Prague

Today will be a free day in Prague for participation in a service project in Prague. Tonight we will enjoy a Czech Folklore show and dinner. **B/D**

Day 6 Vienna

After breakfast today we depart for Vienna, capital of the Habsburg Empire and site of the world-famous Hofburg - home to the Spanish Riding School and the Vienna Boys' Choir. See the Baroque palaces, the cathedral and many museums, and wander the elegant arcades and famous Ringstrasse. Upon arrival a local guide joins us for a brief **panoramic tour of the city and a walking tour of the inner ring.** We see the major sights of the city, **Belvedere Palace, the elegant Kärtner Ring, St. Stefan's Cathedral** and more. **B/D**

Day 7 Vienna

Today is a free day to explore on our own, perhaps take the metro to Schönbrunn Palace to visit the summer home and gardens of the Hapsburg Empire, perhaps to take a cruise on the Danube or a walk in the Vienna Woods. This is a city of culture with many options and something for everyone. **B/D**

Day 8 Bratislava

We cross into the Slovak Republic to reach Bratislava, its capital. Upon our arrival in **Bratislava** we check into our hotel and then meet our personal local guide who takes us on a **walking tour of the Old Town - Staré Mesto** - the city's historical heart. **B/D**

Day 9 Budapest

This morning we take a drive along the famous Danube Bend. We stop in **Esztergom** to admire the largest Hungarian Basilica, and enjoy the splendid view from Visegradi Mountains across the Danube plain to the neighboring state of Slovakia. Next we stop in the picturesque artist village, **Szentendre**, for an opportunity to purchase that special souvenir, Herend porcelain, Hungarian embroidery or paprika or to visit one of the many art galleries. In the evening we enjoy a **special Hungarian dinner** accompanied by Gypsy music at a restaurant in Budapest. **B/D**

Day 10 Budapest

Today we meet a **local guide who takes us on a city tour** to acquaint us with many of Budapest's famous sights: **Gellert Hill** with the Citadel, the former fortress built by the Hapsburgs in the 19th century, **Fisherman's Bastion** dominated by **St. Matthias Church** in the **Castle District**, and the **old town Buda**, along with the more **fashionable Pest** where we find many shops and grand boulevards. We have afternoon free before a farewell dinner tonight. **B/D**

Day 11 Return

It is now time to transfer to the **Budapest Airport** for our return trip to the United States. We return, however, with memories of fabulous castles, magnificent alpine landscapes, enchanting cities, wonderful music and a wealth of new friends! **B**
